Justin Duhaime is a passionate musician and guitar teacher on the Ottawa music scene, regularly selling out shows at festivals, venues and house concerts. Duhaime is the first musician to have ever received the Ottawa Arts Council's RBC Emerging Artist Award in 2018. More recently, Duhaime has emerged as a leading figure in the jazz manouche scene in Ottawa with his Django Reinhardt inspired group Gypsy Muse. Duhaime has a self-published instructional guitar book and has been teaching guitar since 2005. He has composed over 40 pieces and is sponsored by DK Guitars.



David Renaud has been immersed in a diverse and rich musical life performing swing, jazz, theatre, orchestral, and studio for 35 years. He has written music for solo, choral, duos, small ensemble, and big band. Dave performs for National Arts Centre Pops concerts, and covers a multitude of doubles for theatre pit orchestras. Dave teaches clarinet for Carleton University's music department.
